What we're doing in class

Language Arts

The students have been working on a couple of narrative writing and recount pieces. We can't wait to see and share the finished product of "A Bad Case of..." These imaginative narrative pieces are based upon David Shannon's book titled A Bad Case of Stripes.

As the month progresses the students will work on some persuasive writing activities. We will also begin to look more in-depth and practice sample EQAO reading, writing and math tasks. We will focus the students written answers around APE (A-answering the question, P-proving the answer with evidence, and E-explaining, elaborating and extending the answer). Our math problem solving will continue to focus on a 3-block method-what I know (WIK), problem solve (PS), final answer (FA). Please feel free to explore the Ontario Ministry of Education and Simcoe County District School Board websites for parent information on EQAO testing. We also have a link on our grade 3 website. Testing will take place the end of May.



Math

We are presently working on the Number Sense and Numeration strand. We have just finished doing some review of place value with numbers in the thousands. We are moving onto adding and subtracting of 3-digit numbers involving regrouping. The grade 2's will be adding and subtracting 2-digit numbers.

Both grades will also be working on multiplication and division. It is suggested that the grade 3 students memorize the multiplication tables to the 7 fact family. This will help them greatly as math questions become more difficult and multi-stepped.

Science

We have started a new unit on Strong and Stable Structures. They need to understand the distinction between strength (the ability to withstand forces that break or alter the shape of an object) and stability (the ability to maintain balance and stay in a fixed position). Students will design and make structures that can support and move a load. We would appreciate any of the donations for our projects listed on our earlier note sent home. Thank you!

The grade 2's are studying Movement in class. We will be examining simple machines.
