Language Arts What fun the students had brainstorming, planning, drafting and writing a variety of narratives. Our "Snow Globe" narrative writing was especially interesting! Please expect these amazing pieces after a short showcase on our classroom/hallway walls!

In reading we continue to focus on the elements of a story. The grade two's have finished their Inference Unit and can confidently answer questions using the APE format (answer, prove, explain). The grade 3's have been busy writing Reading Responses for every story they have read and are just starting their Inference Unit.

Please keep up your reading at home!

<u>Math</u> Both grade 2 and 3 have recently wrapped up the measurement unit with hands-on centres exploring mass and capacity. We are now looking at 2D and 3D shapes. Students will learn how to sort and compare shapes based on the number of sides, vertices and faces as well as referencing greater than, less than or equal to a right angle. We are having fun making shape monsters.

Our next math unit will be Number Sense and Numeration. Students will represent, compare and order whole numbers to 1000. We will add and subtract three-digit numbers and the grade 3's will multiply up to 7x7 and divide 49-7.

EQAO Sample Questions

EQAO sample questions have been embedded in all of our math units, review pages and unit tests. Students are comfortably using a 3block method to solve multi-step problems. They have also been taught to include math language posted on our word wall to consistently respond to math questions. If you wish to try a few at home, please visit the EQAO website and search the parent centre. <u>Science</u> Grade 2 will start two new science units after March Break. Mr. Michie will be teaching Air and Water in the Environment and I will be teaching Movement in the classroom. Grade 3 will study Structures

and Mechanisms.

The students will be moving onto a lacrosse unit shortly.
